5. The bid documents are not transferable.

6. The Vendor shall quote only for one model against the specification of the mannequin shown in the Bid document.

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<u>SCHEDULE – 1</u>

Terms and Conditions:

- 1. This Invitation for Bids (National Competitive Bidding) is open to all eligible manufacturer and/or their accredited dealers and Direct Importers.
- Bid must reach the office of the Mission Director, Pondicherry State Health Society, Victor Simonal Street, 2nd Floor, Health Directorate Complex, Puducherry 605 001by 4.00 p.m. on 31-03-2017. Late Bid will not be accepted under any circumstances and for reasons what so ever.
- 3. All Bids duly sealed must be addressed to the Mission Director, Pondicherry State Health Society, Victor Simonal Street, 2nd Floor, Health Directorate Complex, Puducherry 605 001 and tender Number should be **super scribed prominently** in the covering envelope along with full name and address of the Bidder.
- 4. The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the Mission Director, herein after referred to as "the Purchaser" will in no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tender process.
- 5. It is the responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that their Bid, whether sent by post or by courier or by person are dropped in the Tender Box in the office of the Mission Director, Pondicherry State Health Society, Victor Simonal Street, 2nd Floor, Health Directorate Complex, Puducherry 605001 within the stipulated date and time as mentioned in the tender document. The Pondicherry State Health Society, Puducherry will not undertake any responsibility whatsoever for postal delay in the process of submission of Bids.
- 6. The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bidding documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the bidding documents in any respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of its bid.
- 7. Telegraphic Tender / Tender through FAX will not be considered.
- 8. The Chairman, Procurement Committee (Mission Director, PSHM) is competent to accept a tender in whole or in part and shall have the right to reject any /all the tenders without assigning any reason thereon.

9. Bidders shall submit their bids in two parts as under:

a) Technical bids, in duplicate, consisting of technical details bringing out clearly in a separate sheet, the deviations in specifications if any from that of 'Technical Specifications' and also clause-by-clause compliance of specifications along with the commercial terms and conditions and bid security. Bidder should submit a soft copy (in CD) of Technical Bid in MS WORD format (only technical specifications/details of the goods and services proposed to be supplied under contract) to help in preparation of Comparative Statement which should be inserted in the Technical Bid (Original Copy).

Any discrepancy between soft and hard copy, the hard copy (printed and signed documents) shall prevail.

- b) Price bids showing only prices in a separate sealed cover inside the main cover.
- c) It may be noted that when the main cover is opened on the date and time scheduled for Bid opening, only the technical bids will be opened and read out in public.
- d) Bidders whose technical bids are found substantially responsive will be informed of the date and time of opening of their price bids. Price bids of others will not be opened by the Tender Committee. The Bids should be duly marked and sealed, as "Original", and "Duplicate". The sealed bids viz. Original, and Duplicate of Technical and Price Bids as mentioned above should be put together finally in a big envelope, which should be sealed as per the clause 3 above.
- 10. It may be noted that Technical bids will be opened and read out in presence of bidders or their authorized representative if they desire to remain present on the date and time scheduled for Bid opening.
- 11. The original and duplicate copies of the bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by the bidder or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the bidder to the contract. Written power-of-attorney accompanying the bid shall indicate the letter of authorization. The person or persons signing the bid shall initial all pages of the bid, except for un-laminated printed literature.

- 12. In the event of any discrepancy between original and duplicate bids, the original shall govern.
- 13. The bidder shall complete the bid forms and the appropriate price schedule (Annexure-II and Annexure-III) furnished in the bidding documents, indicating for the goods to be supplied, a brief description of the goods, their country of origin, quantity and prices.
- 14. To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of bids, the purchaser may, at its discretion, ask the bidder for a clarification of its bid. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing and no change in the price or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered or permitted.
- 15. Preliminary examination: The purchaser will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required EMD has been furnished, whether the document have been properly signed, whether the bid validity is as required and whether the bids are generally in order.
- 16. Bid from accredited dealers without proper authorization from the manufacturers shall be treated as non-responsive and shall be rejected.
- 17. Company participating in the tender should have 3 years standing in the supply of the Mannequin. Similar equipments should have been supplied to a reputed hospital / medical college. List of colleges / Hospitals where such Mannequin have been supplied in the last three years should be enclosed along with performance certificate from such Hospital /

College on the satisfactory maintenance of the Mannequin supplied / maintained.

In case of imported Mannequin, third party inspection report must be produced along with the supply of the equipment.

18. The bid shall remain valid for 180 (Hundred Eighty) days after the date of bid opening. The Purchaser shall reject a bid valid for a shorter period. In exceptional circumstances, the purchaser may solicit the bidder's consent to an extension of the period of tender validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. The EMD (bid security) provided under clause 20 shall also be suitably extended. A bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A bidder granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its bid.

19. The contract should be completed within 45 days from the issue of formal supply order.

- 20. The bidder must furnish EMD (bid security) as per the schedule of requirement unless otherwise exempted under Govt. Orders/Rules in force. Each tender must be accompanied by an Earnest Money Deposit amount of Rs. 50,000/- in the form of demand draft in favour of Pondicherry State Health Society, payable at Puducherry. Bank guarantee or payment in any other form will not be accepted for E.M.D.
- 21. The Demand Draft towards EMD should be furnished along with Technical Bid. Non enclosure of EMD with the Technical Bid will result in rejection of the bid without further scrutiny. In the case of firms which are registered with the DGS&D, attested Photostat copy of the certificate issued by the DGS&D should be furnished along with the tender for exempting them from payment of security deposit / E.M.D. Exemption will be admissible only for those items which are approved by the DGS&D. It may be noted that as registered firm, the tenderer is expected to abide by the general conditions of the contract governing the DGS&D rate contract as well as this Mission's terms and conditions, as amended from time to time. Failure on the part of tenderer to abide by the terms and conditions may result in the cancellation of the contract.

NOTE: Exemption from payment of E.M.D. /S.D is not admissible to Direct Importer irrespective of registration with the DGS&D Unsuccessful bidder's EMD (bid security) will be discharged / returned as promptly as possible. The bidders are advised in their own interest to send a pre-receipted challan along with their bid so that the return of EMD (bid security) after the bid have been rejected, is made within the stipulation period.

- 22. The successful bidder's EMD (bid security) will be discharged /returned upon the bidder executing the contract and after furnishing the Performance security, pursuant to clause 33
- 23. The prices must be quoted in Indian Rupees. Bids, where prices are quoted in any other way shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected and no change at a subsequent date is allowed due to the change in the convertibility of Indian rupees. The bidder shall indicate on the appropriate price schedule (Annexure-III) attached to these documents the unit prices and total bid prices of goods it proposed to supply under the contract.
- 24. Rate quoted should clearly mention one year complete warranty

25. Tender should be submitted detailing the specifications of **Mannequin**. Expected specifications are given in the schedule. When the offer is for an item having different specifications / features, functions, the difference between the item called for and the one offered by the tenderer shall be **highlighted** in the offer itself. The advantages shall also be mentioned.

26. The brouchers / leaflets of product shall also be enclosed with the tender.

- 27. The tenderer should produce attested photocopy of the current manufacturing licence issued by the competent authority including its period of validity. In the case of imported items, the price quoted should be inclusive of Freight and Insurance charges. The Indian customs tariff number under which the customs duty or excise duty has been assessed should also be indicated. The Customs Duty Exemption Certificate will be issued by the competent authority of the Union Territory of Puducherry towards the exemption from the payment of Customs Duty in respect of item to be supplied to Puducherry State Health Mission. Basic Customs Duty and Special Additional duties if any to be payable shall be mentioned clearly in the Price Bid. The tenderer should note that the Mission do not undertake to provide import licence and the acceptance of any tender shall not imply such an undertaking on the part of the Mission.
- 28. (i) In case of imported items, the supplier should arrange for Customs Clearance at his/their Expense.
 - (ii) Demurrage charges and incidental charges if any shall be borne by the supplier.
 - (iii) The consignment shall be transported to the Rajiv Gandhi Women & Children Hospital, Puducherry at the risk and expense of the supplier.
- 29. **Purchaser's right to accept any bid and to reject any or all bids:** The purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject any or all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligations to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the purchaser's action.

30. Evaluation of Quotations:

a. The Bids Shall be Evaluated based on the Technical Specification for the Mannequin its warranty Provided by the firm, and the lowest rate will be arrived at comparing the rates for each mannequins and the total cost for the whole lot of mannequins required for the Hosptial.

Notification of award: Prior to the expiration of the period of bid validity, the purchaser will notify the successful bidder in writing, by registered letter or by cable or telex or fax (to be confirmed in writing by registered letter), that its bid has been accepted. The notification of award will constitute the formation of the contract.

- 31. **Signing of contract:** At the same time, the purchaser notifies the successful bidder that its bid has been accepted, the purchaser will send the bidder the contract form provided in the bidding documents, incorporating all agreements between the parties. The successful bidder shall sign and date the contract form provided in the document. A registered Power of Attorney is to be supported with the bid in favour of the person(s) who will sign the bid as well as contract form if contract is awarded. (**Annexure-XII**)
- 32. **Performance Security:** Immediately after the receipt of notification of award from the purchaser, the successful bidder shall furnish the Performance Security. The supplier shall furnish Performance Security in the form of Bank Gurantee to the purchaser for an amount of 5% (Five **percent**) of the order value, valid for the period of six months beyond the warranty period. In case of foreign companies 5% Bank guarantee on the basis of L.C. covering the warranty period of minimum 3 years should be produced towards Security Deposit. However, if the supplier fails to execute the order or fails to perform the services as per contract in addition to other panel actions, the performance security shall be encashed & the amount forfeited.
- 33. Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirement of clause 31 or clause 32 shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the EMD (bid security), in which event the purchaser may like the award to the next lowest evaluated bidder or call for new bids.
- 34. The proceeds of the Performance Security shall be payable to the purchaser as compensation for any loss resulting from the supplier's failure to complete its obligations under the contract.
- 35. **Inspection and tests**: The purchaser or its representatives shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the contract. The purchaser shall notify the supplier in writing of the identity of any representatives for this purpose.
- 36. The inspections and tests may be conducted on the premises of the supplier, at point of delivery and/or at the goods final destination, where conducted on the premises of the supplier, all reasonable facilities and assistance including access to drawings and production data shall be furnished to the inspectors at no charge to the purchaser. Should any inspected or tested goods fail to conform to the specifications, the purchaser may reject them and the supplier shall either replace the rejected goods or make all alterations necessary to meet specification requirements free of cost to the purchaser, within a period of **15 (fifteen)** days of intimating such rejection. The purchaser's right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the goods after the good's arrival at the final destination shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by purchaser or its representatives prior to the goods dispatch from the place of manufacture.

37. Nothing in clause 36 shall in any way release the supplier from any warranty or other obligations under the contract.

38. Qualification Criteria:

1. The bidder must be a manufacturer or their accredited dealers and had successfully executed contracts for similar and/or identical goods in the past three years prior to the date of Tender opening. In support of this, the bidder shall furnish Performance statement in the enclosed **Annexure-I**.

2. Notwithstanding anything stated above, the purchaser reserves the right to assess the bidder's capability and capacity to perform the contract satisfactorily before deciding on award of contract, should circumstances warrant such an assessment in the overall interest of the purchaser.

39. Warranty:

- i. The supplier warrants that the goods supplied under the contract are new, unused, or the most recent of current models and incorporate all recent improvements in design and materials unless provided otherwise in the contract. The supplier further warrants that the goods supplied under the contract shall have no defect arising from design, materials or workmanship (except insofar as the design or material is required by the purchaser's specifications) or from any act or omission of the supplier, that may develop under normal use of the supplied goods in India, i.e. the country of final destination.
- ii. The warranty should be as per the period mentioned in the Technical Specification.
- iii. The purchaser/indenter shall notify the supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty.
- iv. Upon receipt of such notice, the supplier shall, with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective goods or parts thereof, free of cost at the ultimate destination. The supplier shall take over the replaced parts/goods at the time of their replacement. No claim whatsoever shall lie on the purchaser for the replaced parts/goods thereafter.
- v. If the supplier, having been notified, fails to remedy the defect(s) within a reasonable period, the purchaser may proceed to take such remedial action as may be necessary, at the supplier's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which the purchase may have against the supplier under the contract.
- vi. The warranty for defective parts will begin de novo from the date of replacement. Supplier will pay customs duty and all expenses up to the destination for the replaced part.

40. Reasonability of rates/ firm price:

i. The bidder shall certify that the rates quoted are the lowest ones for any institution in the country.

ii. During the period of the contract, if the price of any tendered item is reduced due to any reason including any Law or Act of the Central/State Government, the bidder shall be statutorily bound to intimate the reduced rates immediately to the purchaser and shall charge the reduced rates. The purchaser is empowered to unilaterally effect such reduction as is necessary in rates, in case the bidder fails to notify or fail to agree to such reduction of rates.

iii. Subject to the condition stipulated above, the prices shall remain firm for the validity period of tender and on no account any increase in price shall be entertained till completion of the tender period.

iv. No bidder will be allowed at any time on any ground whatsoever, to claim revision of or modification in the rates quoted by him. The representation of the bidder that computation/ typographical or clerical error etc. has been committed in the bid and request for reversion on such plea shall not be entertained after opening of the bid.

41. **Contacting the Purchaser:** No bidder shall contact the purchaser on any matter relating to its bid, from the time of the bid opening to the time the contract is awarded. Any effort by a bidder to influence the purchaser in the purchaser's bid evaluation, bid comparison or contract award decisions shall result in the rejection of the bidder's bid and also banning of business dealings with the bidder for a period of three years from the date of such ban.

42. Documents establishing good's eligibility and conformity to bidding documents:

The bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the eligibility and conformity to the bidding documents of all goods and services, which the bidder proposes to supply under the contract. The documentary evidence of the goods and services eligibility shall consist of a statement in the price schedule. The documentary evidence of the goods and services conformity to the bidding documents may be in the form of literature, drawings and data and shall furnish:

- i. A detailed description of the goods essential technical and Performance characteristics,
- A clause-by-clause commentary on the purchaser's 'Technical Specification' demonstrating the goods and services substantial responsiveness to those specifications or a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the 'Technical Specifications

43. Definition of Technical Specification: For purposes of the commentary to be furnished to clause 43 (ii) above, the bidder shall note that standards of workmanship, material and equipment and references to brand names or catalogue numbers designated by the purchaser in its 'Technical Specifications' are intended to be descriptive only and not restrictive. The bidder may substitute alternative standards, brand names and/or catalogue numbers in its bid, provided that it demonstrates to the purchaser's satisfaction that the substitutions are substantially equivalent or superior to those designated in the 'Technical Specifications'.

44. Statutory taxes/ duties :

In case of any enhancement of Taxes and/ or duties or levy of fresh Taxes/ duties due to Statutory Act of the Govt., after date of submission of the tenders and during the contractual delivery period, additional or fresh levies so imposed will be allowed to be claimed as extra without any change in the price structure approved under the tender. For this purpose, the supplier shall produce a certificate from the authority concerned certifying that the item supplied falls under particular tariff resulting in additional/ fresh levies for the supplied item. However, the same shall not be borne by the purchaser in case such levies become applicable after expiry of the contractual delivery period stipulated in the contract. Further, in case the bidder has been enjoying Excise Duty exemption on any criteria like turnover etc. and at a later date, during currency of the contract, even if Excise Duty becomes chargeable on goods manufactured, the same shall be to the supplier's account and shall not be borne by the purchaser.

- 45. Force majeure: The above condition of delivery period, price reduction & termination etc. are subject to force majeure conditions which are beyond the control of the supplier, do not involve fault or negligence of the supplier and are not anticipated. Such events may include but are not limited to riots, mutinies, war, fire, storm, tempest, flood, epidemics, or other exceptional causes like quarantine restrictions, freight embargoes. On specific request made by the supplier the time period of supply may be extended by the purchaser at his discretion for such period as may be considered reasonable. However, the condition shall not include scarcity of raw materials, power cut, labour dispute, failure of sub-vendor and increase in cost of raw material.
- 46. **Fraud & Corruption:** The bidders, suppliers & contractors shall observe the highest standard of ethics during bidding and during performance of the contract. For the purposes of this provision, the following acts shall be considered as corrupt and / or fraudulent practices –

- i. "Corrupt Practice" means offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting directly or indirectly, of any thing of value to influence the action of an official in the procurement process or in contract execution.
- ii. "Fraudulent Practice" means misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to execution of contract.
- iii. "Collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the purchaser, designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive level.
- iv. "Coercive Practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in a procurement process or in execution of a contract.

During the process of evaluation of a bid or proposal for award of a contract, if it is detected that a bidder directly or through agent has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practice in competing for the contract in question, then

- i. the bid shall be rejected and
- ii. Declare the firm ineligible for a specific period or indefinitely to participate in a bidding process. In the bid document itself, an undertaking has to be furnished in the format at **Annexure-VII.**
- 47. Local conditions: It will be imperative on the bidder to fully acquaint himself of all local conditions and factors that would have any effect on performance of the Contract. The purchaser shall not entertain any request for clarifications from the bidder regarding such local conditions nor shall accept any offer conditional to the local factors. No request for any change of price or extension of time schedule of delivery of goods shall be entertained after purchaser accepts the bid.
- 48. Adjudication/Review board: Any dispute arising out of or during execution of the contract shall be settled with mutual agreement through an Adjudication/ Purchase Committee Nominated by the Secretary (Health)/ Chairman Executive Committee of Pondicherry State Health Society.
- 49. **Saving clause:** No suit, prosecution or any legal proceedings shall lie against Tender Inviting Authority or any person for anything that is done in good faith or intended to be done in pursuance of tender.
- 50. Laws governing the contract & jurisdiction: The contract shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws in force in India. All disputes shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

51. Payment Terms:

- Source of Fund: The Pondicherry State Health Society, Govt. of Puducherry has received Grants from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare Services, Government of India (Domestic support) for the Financial Year 2016-17 and intends to apply a portion of this fund to eligible payment under the contract as per Record of Proceedings issued.
- 2. **Procedure for payment**: The paying authority on production of the following documents shall make Payment as below.
 - a. Invoice in triplicate are to be submitted to the paying authority along with the other documents after completion of the supply.
 - b. Stock Entry Certificate is to be obtained in the body of the Invoice in triplicate.
 - c. The original Challan Copy.
 - d. Test certificates.
 - e. Warranty certificates.
- 52. Supply should be made within the delivery period mentioned in the tender or 2 months from the date of issue of the supply order whichever is earlier. In case of delayed delivery, penalty at the rate of 1% per week, of cost of the items not supplied will be levied. If the delay exceeds 4 weeks the order will be treated as withdrawn; unless otherwise the delivery time is extended by the indenting officer.

53. The bidder must submit the following documents along with the others as mentioned above in the Technical Bid with their tender:

- i. Up to date valid VAT registration certificate.
- ii. Up to date valid manufacturing license.
- iii. GRN/TIN and PAN. Income Tax clearance certificate for the last five years i.e. 2010-2011 to 2015-16 should be enclosed to the tender. If the tenderer is not an Income Tax assessee, a non-assessee certificate issued by the Income-Tax Department should be enclosed.
- iv. Literature/catalogue/leaflet in support of the tendered item.
- v. Up to date dealer/ distributor certificate.
- vi. ISO/GMP and other quality certificate issued from competent authority.
- vii. Undertaking in the form at **Annexure-VI** confirming acceptance of all terms and conditions of the tender
- viii. An undertaking on fraud and corruption as per Annexure-VII.
- ix. Manufacturer Authorization letter as per the format enclosed at Annexure-VIII.
- x. The bidders shall duly fill in the agreed terms and conditions as per Annexure IX.

54. Additional Terms and Conditions:

- a. Total monetary value of similar nature of work performed during each of the last three years must be furnished by the bidders which are as follows:
 - i. Experience in works of a similar nature and size for each of the last three years, and details of works underway or contractually committed; and clients who may be contacted for further information on those contracts;
 - ii. Authority to seek references from the Bidder's Bankers;
 - iii. Information regarding any litigation, current or during the last three years in which the Bidder is involved, the parties concerned, and disputed amount;
- b. Bids from Joint ventures are not acceptable.
- c. The bidder must be a profit making one for the last three years.
- d. Bid shall be type written and correction, if any, in the bid shall invariably be attested with full signature by the bidder with date, failing which the bid shall be considered ineligible for evaluation. Corrections done with correction fluid shall also be duly attested.
- e. No article bearing logo gram of any other state / UT other than that of the manufacturer will be accepted.
